Safe in the Panhandle

 Provided an Operational Grant to cover salaries and admin expenses so that donations to the organization could go directly to meeting the needs of survivors during their escape to a safe place.

Rescue America

 Rescue America exists to rescue, revive and empower the sexually exploited through a 24/7 Rescue hotline and emergency response. We have been able to refer survivors specifically seeking a safe home to their organization for help with escape, as we walk alongside providing additional encouragement, ministry and resources.

Empower Her Network

 Empower Her Network partners with trafficking survivors to achieve their economic freedom. We have the honor of being able to nominate survivors that have been out of sexual exploitation for 6 months or greater to become members of EHN and receive support.
